Take Aways from the BQA Beef Quality Audit:

- 1) The Target Consensus for Quality Grade calls for minimal changes from current quality distribution.
- 2) The Target Consensus for Yield Grade change is significantly larger calling for an elimination of Yield Grade 5's and cutting the Yield Grade 4's by 60%!

Summary:

O'Hara Land and Cattle Maine-Anjou bulls can perfectly meet the Target Quality and Yield Grade Distribution by maintaining Quality Grade while significantly decreasing Yield Grade 4's and 5's!
